# **Welcome and Announcements**

Today we celebrate Holy Communion during our LOTV zoom worship connection! Each person or household that wishes to participate will need to prepare some bread (or crackers) and wine (or juice) at home and have it readily available before our worship begins. Then, during the Great Thanksgiving, when Pastor Brian lifts the Bread at the altar during the Words of Institution, everyone at home will do the same, lift their bread. Then again, the same with the wine (or juice) when Pastor Brian lifts it.

Following our praying together The Lord's Prayer, Pastor Brian will again lift the Bread and say, "the Body of Christ, given for you." At this time everyone at home will take bread and eat. If you are single, simply eat as Pastor Brian speaks "given for you." If there are two or more at home you will serve one another repeating the same words, "The body of Christ given for you." There will be a pause as Pastor Brian and Karen share communion which will also allow time for everyone at home to receive the bread element. Then Pastor will repeat the same with the Cup saying, "The blood of Christ, shed for you." Again, everyone at home will do the same. Pastor Brian will pause once more to allow time for everyone at home to receive the cup. After he has returned the bread and cup to the altar, Pastor Brian will share the blessing and the service will continue.

See, I made him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander for the peoples. See, you shall call nations that you do not know, and nations that do not know you shall run to you, because of the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has glorified you.

# Romans 9: 1-5

# After reading – Pastor: The Gospel of the Lord. Congregation: Thanks be to God.

## Matthew 14: 13-21

Now when Jesus heard this, he withdrew from there in a boat to a deserted place by himself. But when the crowds heard it, they followed him on foot from the towns. When he went ashore, he saw a great crowd; and he had compassion for them and cured their sick. When it was evening, the disciples came to him and said, 'This is a deserted place, and the hour is now late; send the crowds away so that they may go into the villages and buy food for themselves.' Jesus said to them, 'They need not go away; you give them something to eat.' They replied, 'We have nothing here but five loaves and two fish.' And he said, 'Bring them here to me.' Then he ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And all ate and were filled; and they took up what was left over of the broken pieces, twelve baskets full. And those who ate were about five thousand men, besides women and children.
