Welcome and Announcements

We will be celebrating Communion during worship this morning. All are welcome! You will need to provide your own elements of bread and wine or juice for Holy Communion.

Call to Worship (Adaptation of Psalm 70 for Confession and Forgiveness)

P) We gather in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

C) Amen

P) The days in which we live are filled with anxiety; there is much that leads to fear and anger.

C) Be pleased, O God, to deliver us; O LORD, make haste to help us.

P) We confess that we give in to the anxiety around us and in us.

C) Too often it leads to harsh words made from judgement that hurts our neighbors and ourselves.

P) We confess that we speak and act too often without regard for others.

C) We have sinned against you, O God, in thought word and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone.

P) Be pleased, O God to deliver us; O LORD, make haste to help us.

C) For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy upon us.

P) Forgive us, renew us, and lead us into new life again this day.

C) Be pleased, O God, to deliver us; O LORD, make haste to help us.

P) God, who is rich in mercy, loved us even when we were dead in sin, and has made us alive together with Christ. By grace you have been saved. Your sins are forgiven, in the name of the Father (+) and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

C) Let all who seek you rejoice and be glad in you; let those who love your salvation say forever, "Great is the LORD!" Amen

Amos 5: 18-24

Alas for you who desire the day of the LORD!

Why do you want the day of the LORD?

It is darkness, not light;

as if someone fled from a lion,

Is not the day of the LORD darkness, not light,

But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who have died, so that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have died. For this we declare to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will by no means precede those who have died. For the Lord himself, with a cry of command, with the archangel's call and with the sound of God's trumpet, will descend from heaven, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up in the clouds together with them to meet the Lord in the air; and so we will be with the Lord forever. Therefore encourage one another with these words.

Matthew 25: 1-13

'Then the kingdom of heaven will be like this. Ten bridesmaids took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. When the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them; but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. As the bridegroom was delayed, all of them became drowsy and slept. But at midnight there was a shout, "Look! Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him." Then all those bridesmaids got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish said to the wise, "Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out." But the wise replied, "No! there will not be enough for you and for us; you had better go to the dealers and buy some for
