Welcome and Announcements

We will be celebrating Communion during worship this morning. All are welcome! You will need to provide your own elements of bread and wine or juice for Holy Communion.

Call to Worship

- P) We worship as we live, in the Grace of God, the Compassion of Jesus Christ, and the Healing Hope of the Holy Spirit.

- C) We come as people yearning, searching for ways to live out our faith. We come, seeking direction and strength to carry on our journey.
- P) Come, you are welcome here. Christ is with us, calling us now to life and love.
- C) Let us celebrate life. Let us worship God.

Thanksgiving for Baptism

(All are encouraged to make a sign of the cross, the sign marked at Baptism, as the worship leader begin.)

- P) Blessed be the Holy Trinity, + one God, the fountain of living water, the rock who gave us birth, our light and our salvation.
- C) In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- P) Joined to Christ in the waters of Baptism, we are clothed with God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us give thanks for the gift of Baptism. (Water is poured in the baptismal font as the worship leader continues.) We praise you for the gift of water that sustains life, and we praise you for the gift of new life in Jesus Christ, the gift of our Baptism. Shower us with your Spirit, and renew our lives with your forgiveness, grace and love. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.

- P) The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
- C) And also with you.

Scripture Readings

After each reading -

Reader: The Word of God for the People of God.

ALL: Thanks be to God.

Genesis 1: 1-5

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. Then God said, 'Let there be light'; and there was light. And God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

Acts 19: 1-7

While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul passed through the inland regions and came to Ephesus, where he found some disciples. He said to them, 'Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you became believers?' They replied, 'No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.' Then he said, 'Into what then were you baptized?' They answered, 'Into John's baptism.' Paul said, 'John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus.' On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. When Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied—altogether there were about twelve of them.

After reading – Pastor: The Gospel of the Lord.


Congregation: Thanks be to God.

Mark 1: 4-11

John the baptizer appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. And people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. Now John was clothed with camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. He proclaimed, 'The one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.'

In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on him. And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.'
