



#### Acts 10: 44-48



Then Peter said, 'Can anyone withhold the water for baptizing these people who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?' So he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. #### 1 John 5: 1-6

Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the parent loves the child. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. For the love of God is this, that we obey his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome, for whatever is born of God conquers the world. And this is the victory that conquers the world, our faith. Who is it that conquers the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

This is the one who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ, not with the water only but with the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one that testifies, for the Spirit is the truth.



#### **Gospel Reading**

#### John 15: 9-17

[Jesus said:] As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete.

'This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. I do not call you servants any longer, because the servant does not know what the master is doing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to you everything that I have heard from my Father. You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name. I am giving you these commands so that you may love one another.

#### AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM

#### Presentation

A sponsor or another representative of the congregation presents those making affirmation.

I present Gretta Roehrs and Annabelle Scott who desire to make public affirmation of their baptism.

Leader: Let us pray, Merciful God, we thank you for these sisters in Christ, whom you have made your own by water and the Word in baptism. You have called them to yourself, enlightened them with the gifts of your Spirit, and nourished them in the community of faith. Uphold your servants in the gifts and promises of baptism, and unite the hearts of all whom you have brought to new birth. We ask this in the name of Christ.

ALL: Amen.

#### **Profession of Faith**

The presiding minister addresses those making public affirmation of baptism.

Leader: I ask you to profess you faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Leader: Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? If so, respond, "I renounce

them."

Confirmands: I renounce them.

Leader: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God?

Confirmands: I renounce them.

Leader: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God?

Confirmands: I renounce them.

The presiding minister addresses the assembly.

Leader: Do you believe in God the Father?

ALL: I believe in God, the Father almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.

Leader: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

ALL: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell, on the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Leader: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

ALL: I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting.

#### Affirmation in the Presence of the Assembly

The presiding minister addresses those making public affirmation of baptism.

Leader: You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in holy baptism:

to live among God's faithful people,

to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper,

to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed,

to serve all people, following the example of Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Each Confirmand responds: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me. The minister addresses the assembly.

Leader: People of God, do you promise to support these sisters in Christ and pray for them in their life in Christ?

ALL: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.

Those making affirmation may kneel. The presiding minister prays for God's blessing.

Leader: Let us pray. We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give us new birth, cleanse us from sin, and raise us to eternal life.

The blessing is repeated for each person. As they are called forward family and friends are invited to join them.

Leader: Father in heaven, for Jesus' sake, stir up in (name) the gift of your Holy Spirit; confirm her faith, guide her life, empower her in her serving, give her patience in suffering, and bring her to everlasting life.

ALL: Amen.

Those making public affirmation stand and face the assembly.

Leader: Let us rejoice with these sisters in Christ.

ALL: We rejoice with you in the life of baptism. Together we will give thanks and praise to God and proclaim the good news to all the world.




Leader: Let us pray. Merciful God,








### **Eucharistic Acclamation 3**




## "Through Christ, with Christ, in Christ"




#### **Distribution of Communion**
